## **P & C Meeting Report**

**March 2008**

**Preamble:** The first fundraising meeting was held on Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2008 (11 people in attendance, 1 apology)

### **2008 Overview**

#### **Term 1:**

- Welcome Disco (was held on 16<sup>th</sup> February more of a “Fun Event” than a “Fundraiser”).
- Treat times (approx 2/month) with “Shock Coffee Van” 50c per cup given to PRSS.
- Chocolate Drive (currently underway).
- Election Day (Sat 15<sup>th</sup> March) – cake stall, raffle tickets, sausage sizzle .....
  - Queensland Government Grants – “Westside News” has advertised government grants of between \$2,000 and \$10,000 for community-based projects and events. Submissions must be received by COB 13/4/08 – Mike Price to further investigate.

#### **Term 2:**

- Mothers’ Day Stall (Thurs 8<sup>th</sup> May?) actual date Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> May. Need a venue to sell items.
- Gold Entertainment Books Distributed – Vicky Shoebridge has offered to co-ordinate this F R and is currently liasing with the book provider.
- Library Opening – This is an official school event (organised/co ordinated by Vicky Richards Acting Principal) occurring possibly around Friday, 20<sup>th</sup> June. It is proposed to be a cocktail (i.e. beer and wine) party with or without a gold coin donation entry fee. Possible fundraising opportunity with a raffle or silent auction.
- Treat times (approx 2/month) with “Shock Coffee Van” 50c per cup given to PRSS.
- School calendar (for 2009) underway (Katrina and Kevin Spark to create, Kate Jones to be contacted for sponsorship of the printing cost). To be ready for sale on the 2009 booklist.

#### **Term 3:**

- Fathers’ Day Stall (Thurs 4<sup>th</sup> Sept?) actual date Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> Sept.
- **MAJOR FUNDRAISING EVENT - Art & Music Soiree** – It was discussed this would be the major fundraiser for the year expanding on previous years to possibly incorporate the Saturday/weekend in the form of an art show involving local artists and the greater community.
  1. Soiree date is already set for Friday, 5 September.
  2. The children’s/other school art will be for sale on the Friday night with the intention that all art is sold.
  3. In addition to individual pieces there can be class/grade pieces and also teachers’/tuckshop ladies’ art work.

4. The class/grade pieces can be photographed and offered for sale (maybe A4 size) as prints for \$10.
5. Katrina Spark has offered to photograph the pieces.
6. These photographs can form the basis for wine labels if we conduct a WINE DRIVE during the year.
7. On the Saturday (6/9) we can have a large marquee displaying local artists and stalls offering art classes/face painting/jewellery making/etc.
8. Local artists will need to pay to display and will be asked to donate a sales commission to the school.
9. Entry to the “art gallery” will be by gold coin donation (or set at \$2).
10. Monster raffle with tickets presold at The Gap and Keperra shopping centres as well as on the day.
11. Vicky Richards (acting Principal) agreed to discuss the revamped Art/Music Soiree with PRSS Staff.
