## **MAJOR FUNDRAISING EVENT — PRSS Art Show – To be held at The Gap Pastime Club**

- Mike Price has secured the venue of the Pastime Club
- Canvasses have been purchased by the P&C at a cost of approx \$1000.
- Committee endorsed title of “*Payne Fully Arty*”.
- We want art ready to view from 3pm to attract parents who are unable to come in the evening so that they may come straight from “pick up”.
- Entry is by gold coin donation. (Per person or family needs to be decided before the day.)
- Gold coin donation buys you a lucky door peg with prizes drawn regularly throughout the night. You must be present to win.
- Doors open 3pm. Bar open from 5pm. Other times to be discussed at next meeting.
- Possible catering ideas include sampler plates of donated food with 5-6 items each, all plates containing the same items. Maybe a hot dog, drink and glow stick for \$5 for the kids?
- Could Yr 7 leaders/students serve food?
- Live band to entertain.
- *Real* artists work for display and sale
- We would like to have a wine raffle using the left over from the election raffle.
- First “Art Show Update” went out to all families this week – these will continue to be distributed after each FR meeting to assist in further disseminating information to the school community.
- **Catering on the Night** –
- We will be pre-selling the food (like a meal deal).

- **Getting the Art Completed** – Offers of assistance for class teachers requiring help have been extended. Some classes are well underway with their pieces.

**UNDERSTANDINGS:**

1. Every child has a piece of art (on canvas) which will be displayed (gallery style) and is for sale on the night.
2. In addition to individual pieces there will be class/grade pieces, Admin Art, P & C Art, Secret Men's business Art, teachers'/tuckshop ladies' art work, also Kate Jones MP has offered to contribute a piece - these pieces will be auctioned.
3. The class/grade pieces can be photographed and offered for sale (maybe A4 size) as prints for \$10.
4. Katrina Spark has offered to photograph the pieces.
5. These photographs can form the basis for wine labels if we conduct a WINE DRIVE during the year.
6. Entry to the "art gallery" will be by gold coin donation (or set at \$2).
