## **P & C Meeting Report**

August 2008

**Preamble:** Focus has been on our key fundraising event: “Payne Fully Arty” Art Show – Fri 5 Sept

### **Current Events:**

- **GWSS Rewards:** Karen Galligan coordinating this event. Information has been in school newsletters and P and C email newsletter. Teachers are collecting docketts at school and forwarding them on to Karen – she has offered prizes to the “best class collection” at intervals throughout this term. The next docket collection date from classes has been extended by one week (to 23/8) due to the shorter week.

### **MAJOR FUNDRAISING EVENT – PRSS Art Show – To be held at The Gap Pastime Club**

- SESSION 1 - Art show opens at 3pm with doors closing at 6pm. This session is for the children to attend.
  - Entry is by gold coin donation PER PERSON;
  - No lucky door prizes during this session;
  - Raffle tickets will still be available for purchase;
  - Individual pieces are for sale at this session (and remain for sale throughout the night);
  - Bids can be made on the larger pieces with a reserve of \$50 unless there is a higher pre-bid.
- SESSION 2 – Doors reopen from 7pm – 11pm. This session is strictly for adults only.
  - Tickets are \$20 which includes a meal. For catering purposes tickets need to be pre-purchased indicating meal choice. *Tickets are available for purchase at the door on the night for the same cost however will not include a meal. This is to be clearly expressed on the invitation/ordering form which goes home.*
- **Ticket Orders** – Another ticket order form will also be sent home with the newsletter hopefully prompting ticket sales.
- **Catering** – It was agreed there be 1 x chicken dish; 1 x beef dish and 1 x vegetarian dish all served with rice. Plans can’t really be made until ticket sales are known. – Still required to borrow slow cookers and rice cookers on the day of the art show!!!!
